



Project Overview:

The Surrey Hospitals Foundation is seeking a full-service production company to provide AV, lighting, and technical support for the 2026 Celebration of Care Gala. The selected vendor will be responsible for delivering a high-impact guest experience through immersive lighting, seamless audio/visual execution, and overall technical management of the event. The event will host up to 500 guests and feature live performances, a keynote program, and multimedia presentations.

Scope of Work & Deliverables:

Technical Production

- > Floorplan Creation
 - Scaled CAD layouts showing guest tables, stage, AV positions, decor zones, and tech placements
- ➤ Lighting Design & Execution
 - Ambient lighting (uplighting, pin spots, color washes)
 - o Intelligent lighting for stage and dance floor (moving heads, effects)
 - o Custom gobos or projections to enhance the theme

➤ Audio

- o PA system for full ballroom coverage
- Wireless handheld and lavalier microphones
- Audio mixing and playback (for performances / videos)
- ➤ Video & Visuals
 - Video production: IMAG/live feed to large screens, switching equipment
 - LED wall or projection setup
 - Video switching and playback
 - o Pre-loaded sponsor visuals, videos, and speaker intros
- ➤ Stage Set-Up
 - Platforms and stairs
 - Placement planning for speakers, MC, performers
- > Power distribution
 - Supply and management of sufficient power of AV, decor, catering, and other vendors
 - Safe cable management
- ➤ Health & Safety Support





- Provide a certified First Aid Attendant who meets or exceeds WorkSafeBC
 Occupational First Aid Level 1 requirements or higher
- o Attendant must be present on site from load-in through event teardown
- Minimum Level 1 Kit with transport supplies
- Collaborate with event planner and venue team to identify emergency exits and response stations
- ➤ Wi-Fi & Connectivity Support
 - Provide and install Wi-Fi boosters or extenders to ensure strong, stable internet connectivity throughout the event space
 - Assess signal needs and provide coverage in critical zones
 - Ensure connectivity supports:
 - Production equipment and live feed
 - Event staff and key vendors
 - Any interactive or digital displays

Run Of Show Management

- > Cue Calling & Live Stage Management
 - Calling all on-stage cues, including speaker walk-ons, performance starts, transitions, and sponsor recognitions
 - Music transitions (intro/outro music, ambient background)
 - o Coordinating live visuals, audio, and lighting changes in real time
 - Keeping the program on time and adjusting as needed
 - Collaborating with:
 - SHF Events Manager
 - Event Planner
 - MC and speakers
 - Entertainment acts
 - Other vendors involved in the program
 - o Managing a dedicated show caller or stage manager throughout the event
 - Maintaining a live version of the run-of-show document backstage
